Some important pointers:

We do understand the challenges faced during a virtual assessment and we will be patient and expect the same from parents. The parents are requested to not panic under any circumstance and reach out to us in case they face any technical challenges during the online assessment. We will help them out and provide a solution. Enough time will be given to the child to complete the assessment in case of any technical difficulty.

Multiple Choice Questions (MCQ)

During the assessment time, the teacher will upload the assessment paper in the assignment section of the team. You must go to the assignment section and click on the link to access the assessment sheet. Teachers will have a demo session for the same in the week preceding the exams, so that the children understand the process.

- The Multiple-Choice Questions will include questions from textbook exercises, worksheets sent by the teachers and, from the textbook chapter.
- For Grade 1 children if they are unable to read the questions and options parents can help them to read or there is also an audio button option (immersive reader) next to each question which can be accessed, and the computer will read out the question to the child.
- Children are requested to keep their video on during assessments and keep themselves on mute.
- In case your child misses the MCQ assessment, he/she will be marked as Absent.

- Please do not disrupt the class assessments by asking questions if you cannot access the assessment sheet, please reach out on the school phone and we will help you with the same. In case of any technical difficulty please reach out on the app or on the school phone.

- **From SA1 (scheduled in Oct) we will have a component of Written Q & A. Children will have to write answers and upload pictures.**

Oral Assessments- (Chapter Understanding)

- The teacher will ask each child questions from the chapters as per the syllabus.
- Oral Marks will consist of 05 marks for the subject matter. The syllabus/chapters will be same as per the FA1 Syllabus.
- In case your child misses the assessment, he/she will be marked as per the teacher's observation during the regular classes.
- Children to be seated without books and parents are strictly requested to not prompt/ help the child.
- Parents are requested to not request for rescheduling their child's assessments.
